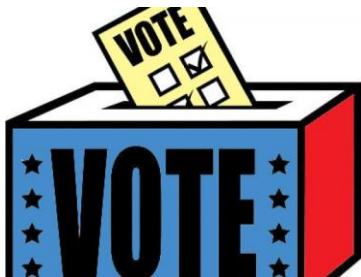

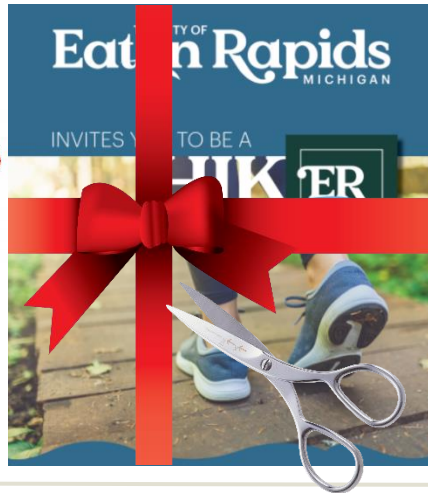
Interesting Fact: Did you know that a cat spends 70% of their life sleeping? That works out to around 13-16 hours a day. Wow! Now that's interesting!

Join us for our annual Scarecrow building contest! The contest is open to all individuals, businesses, organizations and clubs. Registration is REQUIRED to participate, however there is no fee for entry. The contest runs from October 12, 2021 - November 9, 2021. Entrants are responsible for bringing their fully assembled scarecrow to their desired location on Main Street, Downtown Eaton Rapids. Industrial zip ties are available at City Hall if you need them. A number will be assigned to you after registration, that number must be clearly marked on your scarecrow. All scarecrow entries will remain on display outside for the duration of the contest, their construction should be durable and able to withstand cold, wet and windy climate. No perishable goods should be used in the construction or display. ER Arts Council reserves the right to refuse/remove any scarecrow that does not hold up to natural elements. NO GLASS! To vote on the scarecrow you like best, you can either stop in to City Hall or visit the Arts Council's Facebook page during the contest dates.
