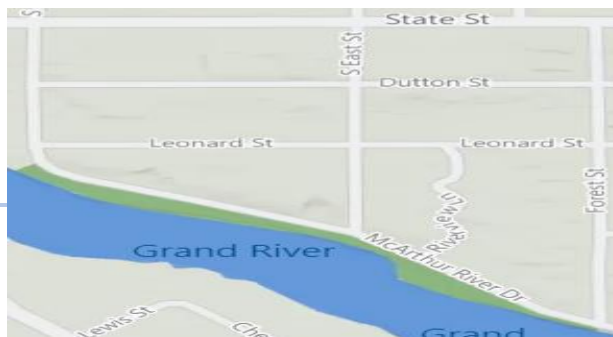

PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

If you were not able to pay your property taxes by the due date of September 1st, there was a 3% Late Fee added to your bill. There will be another 1% added each month until they are paid. ALL taxes can be paid at City Hall thru February 28, 2023. Payments made after February 28, 2023 need to be paid at the Eaton County Courthouse – 1045 Independence Blvd, Charlotte, MI 48813.
