**City Council Worksession**

A Worksession of the Eaton Rapids City Council was held at City Hall, 200 S. Main Street, on December 27, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Colestock and Councilpersons Steele, Nicholas, Robison, and Politza.

**New Business:**

1. Police Chief Weeks presented and reviewed with Council the proposed changes to the front yard parking ordinance. City Attorney Harkness contributed. City Attorney Harkness will make some changes and bring back to Council for review.
2. City Manager Ridge presented and reviewed with Council the Center for Internet Security Assessment. The assessment was part of a grant from Eaton County. The next steps include developing a plan of action to implement changes.
3. City Manager Ridge provided an update to the audit status. The census information was not correct so the financial statements will have to be redone and the auditors cannot make the changes by December 31<sup>st</sup>. Ridge is filing for an extension. Mayor Colestock advised she is scheduling a meeting with Maner and City Manager Ridge.

Ridge provided an update on Horner Mill property. City Attorney Harkness contributed.
