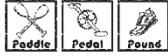

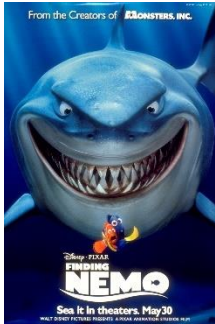

Reduce The Pollution:

Did you know research has shown that light from our porch and security lights are major sources of insect decline? Studies have shown that nighttime light pollution alters migration patterns and habits, negatively impacts navigation in certain species, alters predator/prey relationships, and interferes with reproduction.

Turning off your lights at night is an easy way to help local pollinators. If this isn't an option, consider installing motion sensors that only turn on when movement is detected. Capping exterior lamps which direct light downward is also helpful. Even replacing white bulbs with yellow or amber colored bulbs helps, given that these colors are less attractive to nocturnal species.

If you are planning to install or have installed a swimming pool with water that is more than 24 inches deep then you need to obtain a building permit and electrical permit from the City. The Building and City code requires the permit and that pools with more than 24 inches of water have a 48-inch barrier installed around the pool. The building code specifies what this barrier can be constructed of. Also, the ladders have to be removed from the pool when not in use. This is for the safety of children who can get into the pool and drown. Please contact the building department to obtain the required permits.
