OFFICE PAPER	Office/desk paper, envelopes, bagged shredded paper	Loose shredded paper, excessively dirty/wet materials
MAGAZINES	Magazines, junk mail inserts	Excessively dirty/wet materials
NEWSPAPER	Newspaper	Excessively dirty/wet materials
KRAFT PAPER	Brown Paper Bags	Excessively dirty/wet materials
CARDBOARD	Cardboard – must be flattened, remove all packing materials	Excessive grease/residue, refrigerator boxes including beverage cartons, freezer boxes, molded fiberboard
BOXBOARD	Cereal, cracker, tissue boxes, flattened, remove bags	Boxes with grease or residue, refrigerator and freezer boxes
PLASTIC #1 (PETE)	Clear bottles & jars only – rinsed and caps off	Clamshells, cups, caps or lids, excessively dirty containers
PLASTIC #2 (HDPE) NATURAL	Milk jugs (see through), rinsed, caps can stay on	Excessively dirty containers
PLASTIC #2 (HDPE) COLORED	Milk jugs (not see through), detergent bottles, rinsed, caps can stay on	Excessively dirty containers
PLASTIC # 5 (PP)	Tubs: cottage cheese, yogurt butter, cups, deli containers, rinsed	Rigid plastics, excessively dirty containers
STEEL/TIN CANS	Steel and tin cans	Cans with food residue or excessively dirty items
ALUMINUM	Cans, foil, and trays	Items with food residue or excessively dirty items
BATTERIES	Household AA, AAA, C, D, 9-volt, lithium (24 volt or less), cell phone & button (watch & hearing aid) batteries	Commercially generated, automotive, motorcycle or boat, cracked or leaking batteries
GLASS	Glass beverage and food containers (all colors), candle jars (some wax residue is okay) labels can stay on	Windows, Pyrex, dishware, ceramics, porcelain, china, mirrors, light bulbs, no broken containers
